(Prepared by the Intersessional Working Group on WPA 50 and the Secretariat)

- 1. This draft Work Plan is based on the Work Plan for 2021-2024 (<u>Resolution 9.1</u>). The table contained in Annex 1 to this document combines activities from the Work Plan and issues included in the outline for the reporting format for ASCOBANS. The structure is based on that of the Agreement's Conservation and Management Plan as far as applicable. The related draft Resolution is available in <u>ASCOBANS/MOP10/Doc.5.2a</u>.
- 2. The Intersessional Working Group on Work Plan Activity (WPA) 50 was established at the 28th Meeting of the Advisory Committee to undertake a work prioritization exercise, involving ranking the different activities of the Work Plan. Preliminary prioritisation is indicated in the Annex for each activity.
- 3. Criteria for the prioritisation were applied as follows:
 - High: important topic, severe threat to small cetaceans, or an urgent activity with a defined deadline.
 - Medium: 'low-hanging fruit', relatively easy to do or to make progress on.
 - Core / ongoing: activity that is part of the core functions of the Secretariat or the Advisory Committee, or an ongoing activity.
- 4. In some of the Work Plan activities, text has been kept in square brackets so that it can be finalised at MOP10.
